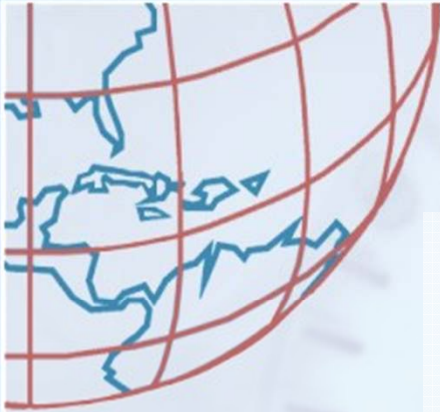

- ICAO standard phraseology and plain English skills are the focus
- As of March 5th, 2008 - Brazil is currently in the three-year transition period

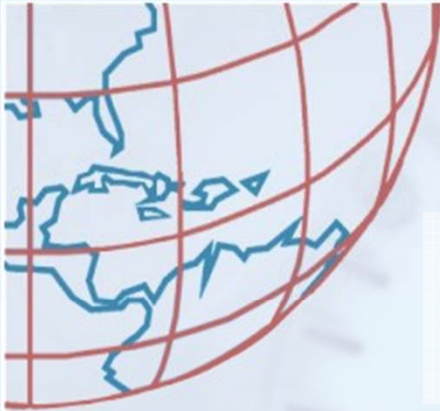

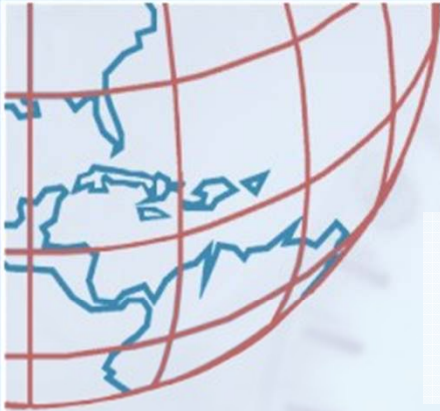
